Important instructions for examination Post– Technical Assistant

- 1. The admit card for the examination does not, in any way, guarantee the selection for the post applied for.
- Candidates should note that their admission to all stages of examination will be purely PROVISIONAL subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility criteria. On further Scrutiny if, any claim made in the application is not found substantiated, the candidature will be cancelled.
- 3. Candidates must bring this admit card, affixing his/her self-attested latest coloured photograph on the specified place for examination otherwise, they will not be allowed to appear in the examination. Do not staple the photograph.
- 4. Candidate are required to bring original as well as a self-attested photocopy of their ID proof e.g. Driving License, Voter ID Card, Aadhar Card, PAN Card, Passport, State/Central Government issued ID card etc.
- 5. Trade Test / Skill Test based on the area of the post concerned will be held in two parts as below:-
- I. Written test (in English medium) for duration of one hour with multiple choice questions / short answer type questions. Each question will carry two marks. 0.5 marks will be deducted for every wrong answer of multiple choice questions.
 Timing: 10.30 AM to 11.30 AM. Venue: CSIR-CIMAP, Lucknow Campus
- II. Trade / Skill Test which will be of qualifying nature. To qualify the Trade / Skill Test, Candidates are required to secure minimum 50% marks.

 Timing: 12.00 noon onwards. Venue: CSIR-CIMAP, Lucknow Campus

Merit will be prepared on the basis of written exam (I) from amongst the candidates who qualify in the Trade / Skill Test (II).

- 6. Candidates should not write/make any personal symbol, name, roll number on any place in their question-cum-answer booklet except at the prescribed space. In case they do so, their candidature may be cancelled.
- 7. Candidates are advised to reach examination centre **30 minutes before the scheduled time**. Candidates will not be permitted to enter in the Examination Hall in any circumstance after commencement of the examination.
- 8. Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any instrument of communication like mobile phone electronic gadgets etc.to the examination venue. Items like bag, book notes etc. are also not allowed inside the examination hall. Candidates themselves will be responsible for the safety of any items brought by them to the examination.
- 9. Candidates are strictly prohibited to exchange anything in the examination hall. Indulging in any malpractice/unfair means in the examination centre will disqualify the candidate.
